

### 30 Hours Childcare Eligibility Verification

Your childcare provider will need to verify your 30 hours eligibility code before offering your child a place. This is done through the local authority using the Department for Education's Eligibility Checking Service (ECS). The eligibility code will be 11 digits long and begin with the number '5000'.

#### What providers will need to verify a parent's 30 hours eligibility code:

- A 30 hours eligibility code
- The parent's National Insurance number
- The child's date of birth
- The written consent of the parent
